



UK contractors and end users to be briefed on ground-breaking performance technology

Industry experts are to give a briefing on ground-breaking new technology being used by Tesco to improve the performance of its refrigeration systems.

Swedish refrigeration pioneer Klas Berglof will present to UK contractors and consultants how the revolutionary Climacheck refrigeration performance analyser works – and how Tesco and other retailers are using it to improve energy performance.
